Authors selected as presenters will need to be paid registrants attending the conference. Presentations are generally 20 to 25 minutes in length with time for questions afterwards for a total of 30 minutes. Longer or interactive presentations may be considered if conference schedule and format allows. Abstracts will be selected for fit among concurrent sessions to be presented on **Thursday, October 22nd, 2020**.

Deadlines

June 19, 2020 – Abstract submittals are due.

July 3, 2020 – Authors will be notified of acceptance in the program.

Abstracts submitted after the June 19th deadline may be included in the conference only if there is space available.
